

The East Catholic Mathematics Department invites all students who were previously enrolled in an Algebra 1 or Geometry class to our "ALGEBRA 2 BOOTCAMP!" this summer.

This readiness course is a review of algebra concepts and arithmetic algorithms and will help students develop good mathematical study skills and learning strategies. Students will explore the following topics:

 Algebraic expressions and integers, solve linear equations and inequalities, writing and graphing linear functions, solving systems of linear equations, polynomial equations and factoring, and graphing and solving quadratic functions.

Students will be introduced to the book they will use in Algebra 2 and will have capabilities to use Math IXL from a computer for additional review.
