Campus Ministry

Campus Ministry, a critical component of the Catholic mission of East Catholic High School, offers a comprehensive pastoral program that includes retreats, spiritual formation, service outreach, peer ministry, bereavement support, spiritual formation of faculty and staff and prayer. Campus Ministry is also a safe and welcoming place for students to come, relax and find companionship.

Additional activities: For juniors and seniors, we offer an overnight Kairos retreat. We also organize schoolwide projects and provide an opportunity to go on service trips. Campus Ministry creates opportunities for students to reflect on their faith and come to know God through various types of prayer, such as the Rosary, Mass, Stations of the Cross, and Adoration.

The East Catholic Religion Department is authentically Catholic and ecumenically welcoming. In the senior year, students learn to appreciate the diversity of faiths that make up our world community through their study of religions of the world. In Religion classes, students learn the essential teachings of the Catholic faith, engage in dialogue, and reflect on how it impacts their own lives. Students are empowered to share their own ideas and think critically about the concepts being taught. We use a variety of teaching techniques to engage each student, such as: collaborative group work; projects; student presentations; seminars; and media presentations.

Serving Others With Compassion

All students participate in a service-learning experience called STRETCH (Service That Requires Engaging The Compassionate Heart)
